### Historic Center of Rome and Coliseum

The tour starts at Rieti's airport. You will stroll around the historic center and discover the city's better known monuments such as the Pantheon, Trinità dei Monti, and Trevi's fountain. There will be a break at lunchtime. In the afternoon you will be able to shop and as well as visit the Coliseum and the Fori Imperiali, the best testimonial of the greatness and magnificence of the Roman Empire. The monument, one of the better known in the world, was built in 70 AD by emperor Flavio Vespasiano.



### Rome – San Pietro and San Callisto Catacombs

You will visit the basilica of San Pietro and see past Pope's tombs as well as climb up on the dome. There will be a break at lunchtime. In the afternoon you will visit San Callisto catacombs.

### ASSISI

The tour starts at Rieti's airport. You will stop to visit Santa Maria degli Angeli, and you will continue on through the historical center of town and visit the basilica of Santa Chiara, as well as San Francesco's Basilica, which is decorated by Giotto's frescos depicting the "Franciscan tales of Assisi". There will be a break at lunchtime. In the afternoon you'll go up to the Eremo delle Carceri where the "Poor Man" would retreat in silence and prayer.

### FARFA and the Valle sommersa

The tour starts at Rieti's airport. You will stop at the dam of Salto to admire the artificial lake that formed after the closing off of the Salto River. This pool of water created during the hydroelectric development politic adopted by the fascist regime in the 1930s makes up one of the most extensive artificial lakes of our peninsula. You will continue on to the sactuary of Santa Filippa Mareri, the first saint of the second Franciscan order who had the opportunity to have Saint Francis as a guest when he was traveling towards Subiaco. You will also visit the chapel that safeguards the remains of the Holy Baroness. The visit will then continue with the Museum of the monastery that is home to some of maestro De Chirico's works, and you get a chance to stroll around Petrella Salto, a small town of great interest that still maintains the old ruins of the Rocca dei Cenci.

There will be a break at lunchtime where you'll be able to try some of the local gastronomic specialties. In the afternoon you will head over the Imperial Abbey of Farfa, monastic center and cultural foundation of the European Middle Ages. You will stroll around this small town and will discover artisan's shops specialized in wood-frame-woven fabrics.



### RIETI underground

You will meet the tour guide in Rieti. This is a guided tour of underground Rieti which still presents the remains of the old roman viaduct, built to prevent the flooding of the via Salaria, the old Salt route. This powerful construction allowed the consuls to enter the city, which thus gained an extremely important role for Roman royalty who needed a direct connection with the city. Great calcareous arches that supported the roadways, many of which can still be found in the basements of some noble's homes, make up its structure.

### Franciscan Sanctuaries

The tour starts at Rieti's airport and will take you to Greccio's Sanctuary, where, on Christmas Eve of 1223, the Poor Man from Assisi put together the first living Nativity Scene in history to present Bethlehem's nativity. You will visit the sanctuary and the Holy Grotto, as well as enjoy the panoramic view of the Holy Valley. You will move on to the sanctuary of Fonte Colombo better known as "Franciscan Sinai" because the Saint wrote the Order's rules, authorized by Pope Onorio III, in this very place. There will be a break at lunchtime.



### PIEDILUCO and Marmore waterfalls

The tour starts at Rieti's airport and will take you to the Sanctuary in the Forest where San Francis wrote the "Canticle of the Sun" and where the miracle of the vineyard took place. You will then head to the Piediluco Lake, guarded by the Rocca Alboronziana, and stroll around town. You will also trek up through the woods that lead down to the lower panoramic view of the Marmore waterfalls.
